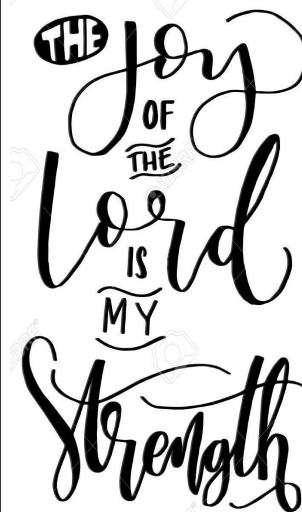
Baptism Blessings!!!
