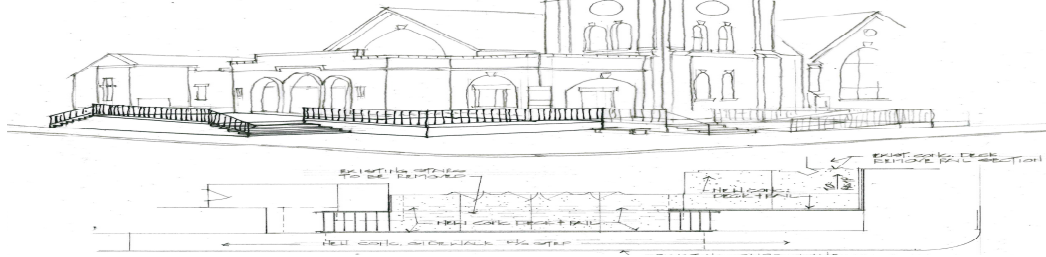
Cemetery Fund
