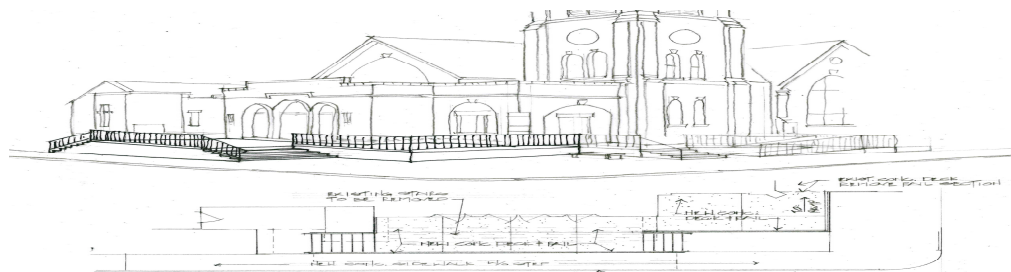
## The 25<sup>th</sup> Annual St. Paul Benefit Auction and Dinner
