CONFIRMATION Information

Summer break is about to end, school is about to begin, and Confirmation classes are about to resume. Our church body (*The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod*) defines Confirmation as "a pastoral and educational ministry of the church that is designed to help baptized children identify with the life and mission of the adult Christian community, and that is celebrated in a public rite."
