TODAY'S LIGHT BIBLE  
Sharpen the Focus:

Most time and money management books begin by asking readers to identify their goals. Until we know what we want to achieve, it's impossible to select a strategy. Scripture too insists that we clearly identify our priorities for life. "Seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these (material necessities) will be given to you as well" (Matthew 6:33). Psalm 37:4 says, in essence, the same thing. Delight yourself in the Lord and He will give you the desires of your heart. Seeking first the kingdom and delighting oneself in the Lord both involve making God's priorities our own. A person with God's priorities weeps over the lost, feeds the hungry, provides for the homeless, comforts the sick, and participates in proclaiming the Gospel. For those who died with Christ and rose with Christ (Romans 6:1-14), these things are not what we "have to do," but what we "get to do." Service becomes a possibility and a privilege. Our Lord promises that He will "give (us) the desires of (our) heart." He will plant in our hearts the seeds of godly desires that will, by His grace, sprout up and grow to produce a harvest of righteous attitudes and actions.
