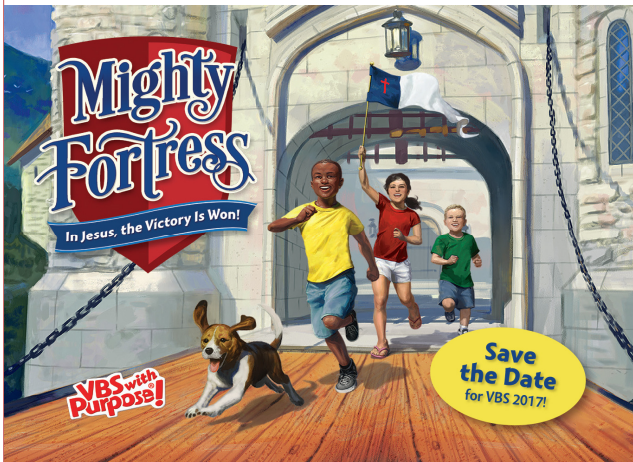
**Voter assembly on June 6 @ 6:30 in the sanctuary.**
