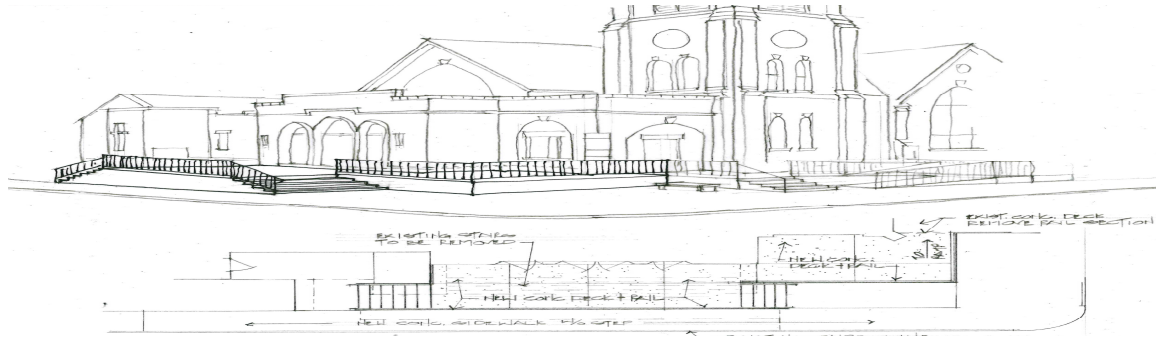

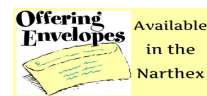


Third S.a. Epiphany

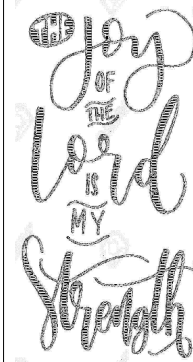
