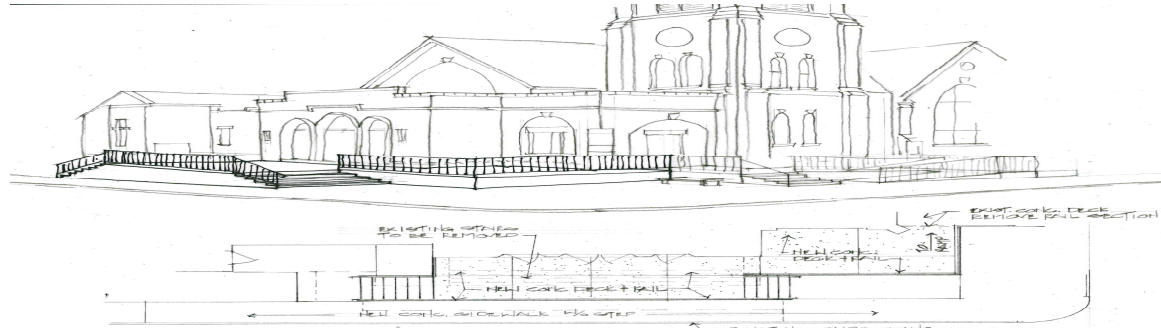


The St. Paul Youth Group that will be attending the National Youth Gathering in Minnesota this summer will be hosting a Chicken & Dumpling Luncheon on

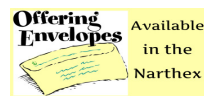
Fourth S.a. Epiphany

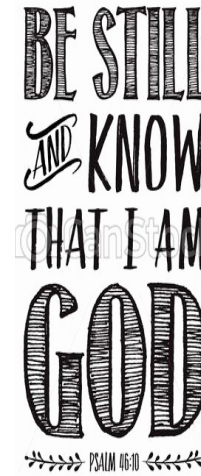
