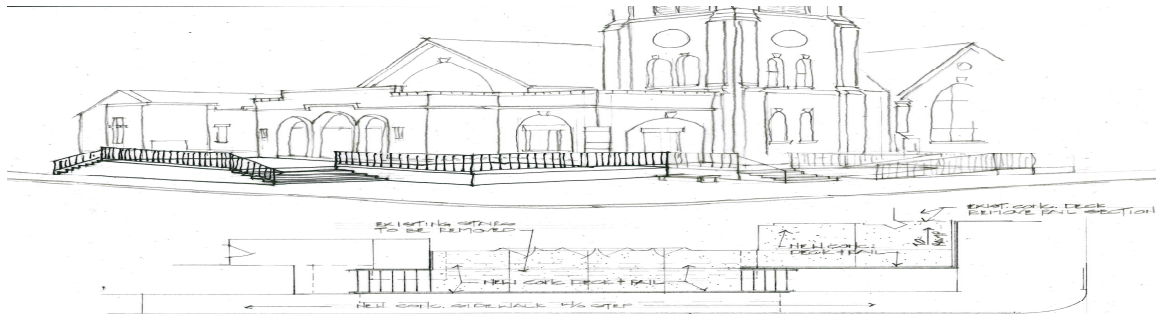
The Youth Gathering Wall of Support

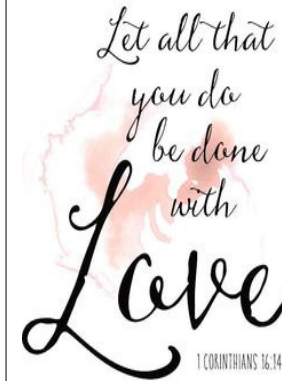
