We need hostesses to invite friends and family to sit at their tables.

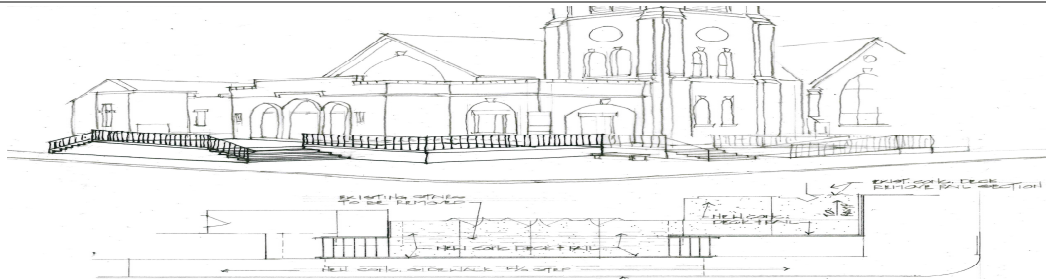
